Article 4 CEPT Arrangement

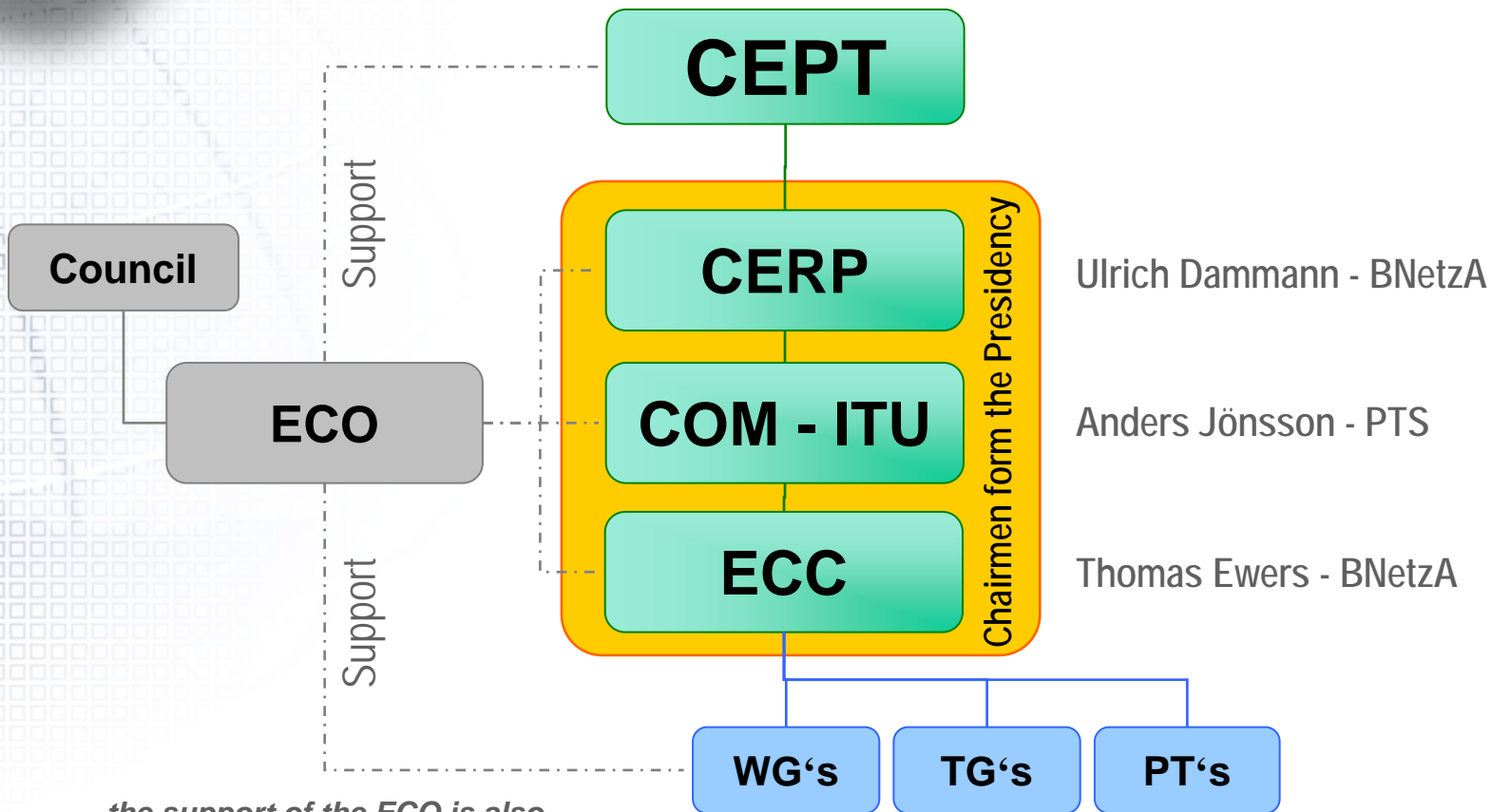


- ***A new approach for the 50th anniversary***

CEPT Assembly:

- ***The CEPT communication function shall be improved, to be effected by the Office***
- ***The Committees shall take a more strategic approach and develop forward-looking work programmes***

CEPT Assembly:

- ***ECC is recommended to take more account of economic factors in its work, for example by conducting impact assessments***
- ***The coordination procedures related to UPU and ITU Conferences to be retained***



CEPT Assembly:

- ***Arrangements for external participation be improved, particularly to develop engagement with new players (emerging industries, small and medium enterprises, academia, consumer groups etc)***
- ***The committees shall review their structure and working methods to improve efficiency and cooperation with other entities (EC, RCC, ETSI, etc.)***

Cooperation within Europe and globally

- **LoU and Mou**
 - **The CEPT maintain nearly 35 LoU and MoU with key organisations (EC, ETSI, ETNO, EBU, EICTA, UMTS Forum, WiMax Forum...) and regional organisations (CITEL, APT, ATU, Arab Group,)**
- **European Union**
 - **The European Commission is counsellor to ECC.**
 - **The cooperation in the radio spectrum area is ensured by the Spectrum Decision.**
 - **The ECC participates in the Radio Spectrum Committee and the Radio Spectrum Policy Group.**
- **Improved cooperation with regional organisations**
- **ECC Deliverables undergo public consultation incl. responses to EC mandates**
